Online First: Quick publication time due to this service which provides access to the electronic version of peer-reviewed articles well before print publication. Online First articles are searchable and citeable by their DOI (Digital Object Identifier) and hence significantly reduce the time to publication.

Editor's Choice: Free access for 3 months to topical full-text articles right after publication, selected by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Dr. Michael J. Parnham.

Open Choice: This option offers authors, against payment of a basic fee, to give worldwide free access (Open Access) to their peer-reviewed and accepted article in electronic form via the internet database SpringerLink. The authors keep the copyright of the article in this case.

Manuscript Central: A fully web-based online manuscript submission and review system is available to authors. This system offers authors easy and straightforward login and submission procedures and the option to track the progress of the review process of manuscripts in real time.

Inflammation Portal: This internet portal provides free access to all abstract issues from past inflammation conferences of the IRA since 2000 and the IAIS since 2005.
